01/08/2010 O Rasul, Iraq, suicide, jumped from 15th floor flat in Glasgow (GB), asylum claim was rejected • 31 July, 5 people, names unknown, drowned, boat capsized off coast of Samos (GR) • 11/07/2010 3 people, names unknown (men), Sub-Saharan Africa, drowned, boat capsized off coast of Samos (GR) • 11/07/2010 fetus, Sub-Saharan Africa, reported missing, dinghy capsized off coast of Samos (GR) • July 10, boy (14), Afghanistan, reported missing, dinghy capsized off coast of Samos (GR) • Zahara Bare (42, woman), Somalia, pre-arranged asylum seeker, died in detention centre in Hamburg (D) • 13/05/2010 Mohamed Abagui (man), Morocco, suicide, jumped from 15th floor flat in Glasgow (GB), asylum claim was rejected • 03/05/2010 name unknown (34, man), Maghreb, deported from NL without family, died while trying to reenter Europe via boat to Samos (GR) • 18/04/2010 name unknown (±25, man), Algeria, drowned whilst swimming to city, body washed up on Chorrillo beach, Ceuta (E) • 16/04/2010 Yeni P. (34, woman), Indonesia, suicide, hanged herself in deportation centre in Hamburg (D) • 15/04/2010 name unknown (40, man), Kenya, died after being denied medical attention by staff at Oakington detention centre (GB) • 13/04/2010 11 people, names unknown (adults), Algeria, reportedly drowned, boat sank off Almeria coast (E) on way from Algeria, 3 survivors • 10/04/2010 name unknown (27, man), Sri Lanka, stabbed by housemate in Venice (I), jealous of his permanent residency and work permit • April 10, name unknown, origin unknown (minor), suicide, depressed after asylum claim was rejected did not receive medical support • 30/03/2010 7 people, names unknown, origin unknown, drowned, boat capsized 3 miles from Kafr el-Sheikh, Egypt on way to Italy, 38 survivors • 28/03/2010 name unknown (15, boy), Afghanistan, asylum seeker, killed by bomb explosion in Athens (GR) while searching for food into garbage • 21/03/2010 3 people, names unknown, Somalia, bodies thrown overboard on the way to Sicily (I), 20 survivors rescued by border patrol • 17/03/2010 Joseph Ndukaku (29, man), Nigeria, died during deportation at Zurich airport (CH), weak from hunger strike, police forcibly restrain • 07/03/2010 David Mardiani (17, man), Georgia, suicide, asylum seeker, hanged himself in Hamburg deportation centre (D) after hunger strike • 06/03/2010 Serge Serykh (man), Kosovo, suicide, jumped with his family from 15 floor flat in Glasgow (GB), asylum claim was rejected • 06/03/2010 Tatiana Serykh (woman), Kosovo, suicide, jumped with her family from 15 floor flat in Glasgow (GB), asylum claim was rejected • 06/03/2010 name unknown (boy), Kosovo, suicide, jumped with his family from 15 floor flat in Glasgow (GB), asylum claim was rejected • 03/03/2010 name unknown (13 months, girl), Nigeria, refused hospital treatment in Cernusco sul Naviglio (I) due to new discriminatory laws • 11/02/2010 6 people, names unknown (men), origin unknown, reportedly drowned, dinghy capsized off coast of Samos (GR) on the way to (GR) from (TR) • 11/02/2010 name unknown (woman), origin unknown, reportedly drowned, dinghy capsized off coast of Samos (GR) on the way to (GR) from (TR) • 11/02/2010 name unknown (girl), origin unknown, reportedly drowned, dinghy capsized off coast of Samos (GR) on the way to (GR) from (TR) • 11/02/2010 8 people, names unknown, origin unknown, reportedly missing, dinghy capsized off Samos Island (GR) on the way to (GR) from (TR) • 16/01/2010 M. Vittore prison, Milan (I) • 10/01/2010 2 people, name unknown, origin unknown, drowned, suspected that boat capsized 6 days earlier, travelling from Turkey to Greece • 04/01/2010 M. Yahya Tabbabi (31, man), Tunisia, asylum-seeker, died in detention centre in Vottem (B) due to lack of medical treatment • 04/01/2010 19 people, names unknown, origin unknown, drowned, boat capsized when travelling from Turkey to Greece • January 10, Wadim S. (±21, man), Latvia, suicide, jumped in front of train in Hamburg (D) after hearing he would be deported • 31/12/2009 22 people, names unknown (7 women, 1 child, 2), Asia, reportedly drowned on way from Turkey, boat shipwrecked off Alexandroupoli coast (GR) • 25/12/2009 Carlos (34, woman), Brazil, suicide, transsexual hanged herself with a sheet in detention center of Milan (I) • 15/12/2009 Maiouad (15, boy), Afghanistan, stowaway, killed crossing a highway near Calais (F), trying to go to GB by hiding in a truck • 12/12/2009 2 people, names unknown, origin unknown, reportedly drowned, boat sank off coast of Leros Island (GR), 25 rescued from rocky islet • 09/12/2009 name unknown (man), Africa, stowaway, frozen to death in a lorry trying to go from Tangeri (MA) to Marseilles (F) • December 09, name unknown, origin unknown, drowned, found off Alexandroupoli (GR) when boat shipwrecked • 24/11/2009 Ibrahim M. B. (35, man), Senegal, murdered by his employer in Vercelli (I) as he did not want to pay him a 3 months salary • 24/11/2009 23 people, names unknown, Comoros Islands, reportedly drowned, boat sank between island Mayotte (F) and Comoros Islands • 20/11/2009 name unknown (30, man), Bolivia, died after repatriation operation after 26 days spent inside detention center of Malaga (E) • 18/11/2009 name unknown (man), Sub-Saharan Africa, reportedly drowned, fell from wooden boat in the sea off the coast of Tarifa (E) • 06/11/2009 6 people, names unknown (1 men, 1 woman, 3 children, 1 baby), Afghanistan, drowned, 5 died, 1 missing, overloaded boat sank off the coast of Bodrum (TR) • 06/11/2009 Abdelkader H. (19, man), Algeria, suicide, jumped in Bilbao's river (E) escaping from policemen who took him for a thief • 01/11/2009 name unknown (young man), origin unknown, stowaway, suffocated, found in the back of a lorry entering the Channel Tunnel (F) to GB • 29/10/2009 3 people, names unknown, Algeria, bodies found on a boat tracked southeast of Cartagena on Spain's southern coast • 27/10/2009 9 people, names unknown (±30, 1 man, 3 women, 5 children), Afghanistan, drowned after wooden boat from TR collided with rocks on the island of Mytilini (GR) • 27/10/2009 name unknown, origin unknown, found on boat escorted to Sicily, I and M refused for 3 days to receive them in their territory • 15/10/2009 16 people, names unknown (1 woman, 1 child), Kosovo, drowned, 11 died, 5 missing, boat capsized trying to cross Serbo-H border via Tisza river • 10/10/2009 Mohammad Atif Kamran (25, man), Pakistan, murdered, beaten, dragged in police station of Nikaia (GR) and tortured till death • 06/10/2009 7 people, names unknown, Egypt/Somalia, drowned, 4 died, 3 missing, trying to swim from a dinghy to the coast of Gela (I) • 19/09/2009 28 people, names unknown (7 women, 1 man), Sub-Saharan Africa, drowned, 8 found, 20 missing, small boat sank off the coast of MA near Perejil Island (E) • 14/09/2009 Gagandeep Singh K. (32, man), India, suicide, died of heart attack due to a month-long hunger strike in prison in Wien (A) • 29/08/2009 name unknown, Maghreb, manner of death unknown, died during boat trip, found in Granadilla, Tenerife Island (E) • 28/08/2009 name unknown (woman), Africa, drowned during rescue operation in Birzebuggia coast (M) on her way from Africa • 24/08/2009 T. (32, woman), Libanon, suicide, overdose to family being moved to an asylum seekers camp in Mittweida (D) • 20/08/2009 72 people, names unknown (55 man, 17 woman), Eritrea, bodies thrown overboard after 23 days traveling from Libya to Lampedusa (I) • 17/08/2009 27 people, names unknown (1 man), Sub-Saharan Africa/Morocco, drowned, 7 found, 20 missing, 10 survived, shipwreck near Trafalgar beach in southern Spain • 12/08/2009 2 people, names unknown, Turkey, drowned, 2 died, motorboat sank off the coast of Kos Island (GR) on the way from TR • 10/08/2009 20 people, names unknown, Somalia, murdered, guards opened fire during their escape attempt from detention centre in Banghazi (LY) • 09/08/2009 name unknown, origin unknown, stowaway, body found on hallway Brindisi-Lecce (I) thrown over truck with 17 survivors • 09/08/2009 12 people, names unknown, Somalia, missing after Benghazi (LY) massacre by police, in detention centre along LY to Italy route • 09/08/2009 6 people, names unknown, Somalia, killed by police in Benghazi massacre (LY), when prisoners tried to escape detention centre • 09/08/2009 Heval Huseyn Ismail (28, man), Kurdistan, suicide, failed asylum seeker who hanged himself in a South Shields park (GB) • 08/08/2009 12 people, names unknown, origin unknown, 1 died, 11 missing, boat collided with Algerian coast guard vessel in the port of Annaba (DZ) • 06/08/2009 F. A. (27, woman), Morocco, suicide, threw herself in the Brembo River in Bergamo (I) in fear of deportation • 03/08/2009 12 people, names unknown (1 man), Algeria, drowned, 1 died, 11 missing, wooden boat capsized 4 miles from Cabo de Palos (E) • 27/07/2009 Arivan Osman Asis (20, man), Iraq, murdered, beaten by border guards in his attempt to embark to reach I, died in GR hospital • 27/07/2009 name unknown, origin unknown, reportedly drowned, parts of a body found along la Fontanilla beach of Marbella Island (E) • 25/07/2009 Luis Beltran Larrosa (56, man), Uruguai, died of heart attack in Tenerife (E), employer did not call for assistance as Luis was illegal • 14/07/2009 name unknown, Sub-Saharan Africa, died at the hospital of El Hierro, Canary Islands (E), after boat arrived in La Estaca harbour • 14/07/2009 Azad Hayi (28, man), Kurdistan, manslaughter, beaten by neonazis whilst returning to Mühlau asylum centre (D) at night • 12/07/2009 2 people, names unknown, Sub-Saharan Africa, 1 died on board during travel, 1 died at the hospital of El Hierro (E) because of dehydration • 01/07/2009 name unknown (man), Sub-Saharan Africa, drowned, body found 42 miles south of Cabo de Gata in Almeria (E) by Liberian ship • 29/06/2009 10 people, names unknown (3 w, 5 m, 1 child), Sub-Saharan Africa, drowned, wooden boat collided with rocks in Barbate Coast (E) • 23/06/2009 Amir Rohol (19, boy), Afghanistan, stowaway, fell from the truck he was hidden, died in hospital 3h later in Ancona (I) • 19/06/2009 name unknown (20, man), Ecuador, suicide in a cell in Barcelona (E) hanging himself with his own shirt, arrested because illegal • 04/06/2009 25 people, names unknown (men, women, 8 babies), Sub-Saharan Africa/Morocco, missing after their boat sank at 10 miles off Tarifa, Cadiz (E) on the way from Tanger (MA) • June 09, name unknown (16, boy), origin unknown, suicide after his asylum claim was rejected in asylum seeker accommodation Varmland (S) • 27/05/2009 Mir Abbas Safari (36, man), Afghanistan, suicide after 67 days in detention centre in Gavle (S) in fear of being deported • 19/05/2009 Jonathan Sزالina (20, man), Ecuador, reported suicide using t-shirt but guards reportedly beat him in Barcelona detention centre (E) • 07/05/2009 name unknown (49, woman), Tunisia, suicide in the detention centre of Ponte Gallera, in Roma (I) • May 2009 2 people, names unknown, Somalia, drowned whilst travelling from Turkey to Greece on Evros River (GR) • 30/04/2009 name unknown (man), Sub-Saharan Africa, died in the hospital in Tarifa (E) after Spanish authorities blocked a boat from Tanger (MA) • 23/04/2009 2 people, names unknown, origin unknown, reportedly died of hypothermia, found by Spanish authorities in the Strait of Gibraltar (E) • 16/04/2009 Esat Ekos (19, pregnant woman), Nigeria, died during rescue operation, boat waited 4 days before to be allowed to reach Italian coasts • 16/04/2009 name unknown (fetus), Nigeria,



Since 1993 UNITED has been monitoring the fatal results of the policies summarised as the building of a 'Fortress Europe'. Around 14.500 deaths (a.o. those listed above) in the period 1993-2010 can be put down to border militarisation, asylum laws, detention policies and deportations. These are the consequences when Europe shuts its doors. UNITED for Intercultural Action - the European network against nationalism, racism, fascism and in support of migrants and refugees - unites more than 550 organisations from 48 European countries.
